- The Winter Showcase will be held at **Westinghouse Arts Academy Charter School**, 320 Marguerite Avenue, Wilmerding, PA, 15148 at 2:30 PM on Saturday, Dec. 9, 2023.
- Dancers are to arrive at 1:30 pm. The show begins at 2:30 p.m.
- All dancers should wear the holiday tee shirt we are ordering or bring a red t shirt for the finale
- Following the performance, you are invited to attend an on-site soiree with refreshments and cookies for all our dancers and guests to celebrate the season.
- There will be a holiday balloon display for fun holiday photo ops...maybe even a visit from Santa.
- Tickets will be required for this event. All tickets are \$10.00 in advance and \$12.00 at the door. Last year we were overwhelmed by the wonderful attendance, please know we will only sell 600 seats. Tickets are non-refundable. All seats are open seating and are not reserved.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

GETTING YOUNG DANCERS ON AND OFF STAGE

- Your child's teacher will meet the dancers in the designated parent drop-off zone at least 4 numbers before their dance backstage (across from dressing room), parents will go watch in auditorium, and following the end of the dance you will pick up your dancer up in the same area and take them back to the dressing room to change for their next dance
- Please be on time to the drop-off zone we cannot wait for anyone late to meet in the drop-off zone. ***FYI: These dances are shorter than the regular recital dances so please keep that in mind that the show will move quickly**

GRAND FINALE

- Teachers will start lining up all dancers for the finale a few numbers (6-8 numbers) before the last dance
- If your dancer is in one of the last 6 routines of the show, please meet them quickly backstage to change into their red shirt and bring them back to line up for the Finale
- Please pay attention to the show order and know the names of your child(s) dances so your dancer doesn't miss anything
- Please remember to stay to the end of the show for the Grand Finale we will
 put all the dancers on stage together at the end and sing a Christmas song
 together ("Rudolph the Red Nose Reindeer") and then our Directors will come out
 on stage to make announcements
- All dancers should be in their RED WINTER SHOWCASE SHIRT or a RED SHIRT of their own for the Finale
- Dancers are welcome to wear a pair of reindeer antlers for the Finale *(if you have them not mandatory)* as we will be singing Rudolph the Red Nose Reindeer
- Parents of young dancers: please pick up your dancer up on stage after the Finale
- The Post-Show Soiree with cookies and refreshments will follow the Finale

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Girl dancers will change in the Gymnasium (across from the stage) *FYI: There are no men allowed in the Girls Dressing Room
- Boy dancers will change in the dressing room backstage
- All dressing rooms will be labeled upon arrival
- Please remember to LABEL everything (shoes, clothes, undergarments, etc.)
- Dancers should be in stage makeup (browns/neutral eyeshadows, eyeliner, mascara, blush, red lips)
- Secure all hair styles with hairspray, gel, bobby pins, etc. and secure all headpieces in place
- No chewing gum is permitted on stage/while dancing
- Please have all required pieces for your dance(s) tights, shoes, accessories, etc.

- When your dancer is done please clean up around the area you were changing in as we are renting this space and need to keep it clean
- Please make sure young dancers go to the bathroom before they go on stage
- You may be permitted to take photos and videos but **NO FLASH**, also please don't hold your camera up over your head obstructing the view of others sitting behind you
- Children should be supervised at all times
- Please do not exit the auditorium during a performance wait for applause!
- The studio is not responsible for any lost items
- Please do not touch any school property or items that do not belong to us
